

Who Do You Call?

Reporting abuse of a person is an important role, but it isn't always clear who you should call to report abuse. The following chart can be utilized to clear up the distinctions of who should receive reports.

In the cases of sexual violence, local rape crisis centers contact information is below.

Who was abused?		Where did the Abuse Happen?		Report To
Person 60 years or Older	If Yes →	Community or Domestic Setting	Then Call →	Adult Protective Services 1-866-800-1409
Person with a disability 18-59 years old	If Yes →	Community or Domestic Setting	Then Call →	Adult Protective Services 1-866-800-1409
Person 60 years or older or a person with a disability 18-59 years old	If Yes →	Licensed Long Term Care Facility	Then Call →	Illinois Department of Public Health 1-800-252-4343
Person with a disability 18-59 years old	If Yes →	Licensed Facility	Then Call →	Office of Inspector General 1-800-368-1463
