Stop Bullying Now!

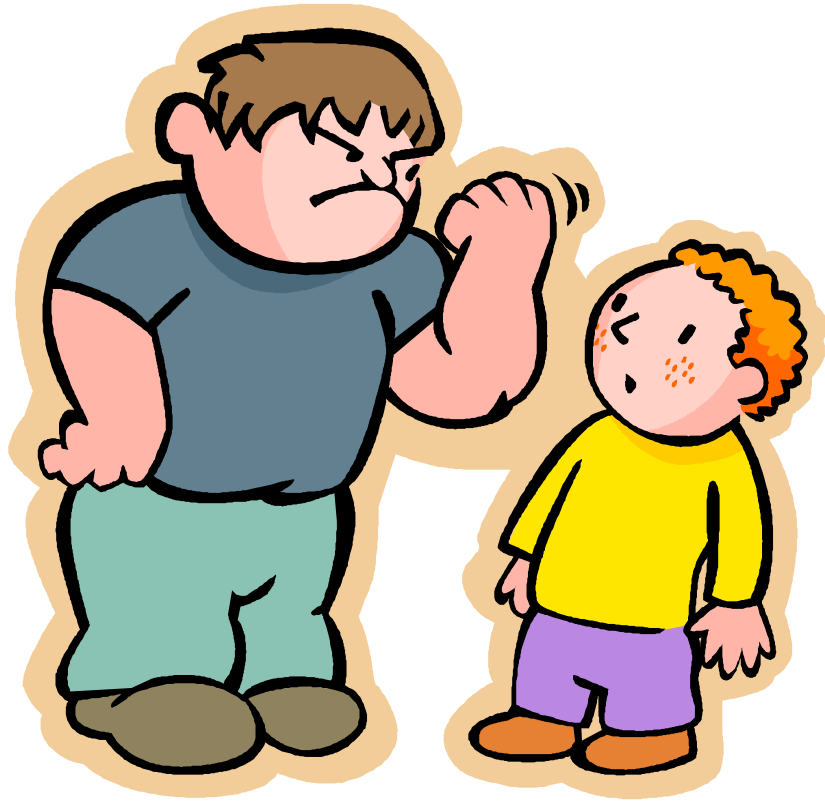
