



Attention!

20,500 members of the U.S. Military were sexually assaulted in 2018.

13,000 victims were women and 7,500 were men.

90% of the cases the rapist was another service member.

The rapist was the same rank or a higher rank in almost all the cases.

11% of women in the Marines were assaulted; 7.5% in the Navy; 5.8% in the Army and 4.3% in the Air Force.

25% of women and 6% of men were victims of sexual harrassment.

Alcohol was a factor in 62% of the assaults.

1 in 4 women who used the VA in 2013 screened positive for military sexual trauma.

Reporting

66% of victims did not report the crime; 43% of women that reported had a negative experience reporting the crime.

In 2019, Military Services received 7,825 reports of sexual assault involving service members - a 3% increase from 2018.

In 2019, Military Services received 2,126 reports of sexual harrassment - a 17% increase from 2018.
